Jeff Barak appears regularly in The Jerusalem Post as a popular guest columnist. His extensive journalism experience includes serving as Senior Editor at the Ha'aretz English-language edition (Dec. 2007–April 2008), Editor for Yedioth Achronot's English-language website Ynetnews.com (Jan. 2007–Oct. 2007), Middle East Editor for the Jewish Chronicle, based in Israel (Aug. 2006–Dec. 2007) and Deputy Editor, then Managing Editor, at the London Jewish Chronicle (May 2002–July 2006).

From 1996–2002, Barak was the Editor-in-Chief at The Jerusalem Post. During this period (1999–2000), he spent a sabbatical year at London's Daily Telegraph, including six months working its website.

Barak oversaw the development and launch of The Jerusalem Post's internationally famous website, a first for any Israeli newspaper.

For many years, Barak served as a lecturer to various groups visiting Israel, either on behalf of The Jerusalem Post, the Jewish Agency or Birthright. He has lectured regularly on behalf of the Jewish Chronicle, Zionist Federation and the Israeli Embassy. Barak has also appeared a regular guest analyst for the BBC and Sky TV concerning Israel and Jewish affairs.
