Pinchas Landau founded Israel Funds Observer Ltd. in 2006 and serves as its Director. Since 1997, he has functioned as a consultant for domestic and foreign financial institutions and from 1985 onwards, Landau has been an Analyst and Correspondent for Israel's Economist Intelligence Unit. Since 1996, he has been publisher and author of the universally respected *The Landau Report*, a monthly newsletter that reviews trends and forecasts of Israel and the regional economy and political sphere.

His prior work includes Managing Director of I-BIZ – Israel Business Information Service (2000-04), Senior Columnist for Globes (Israel's business daily (1988-92; 1995-97) and Finance & Business Correspondent for The Jerusalem Post (1984-89).

Landau is a regular lecturer in Israel and overseas to audiences of academics, professionals and laymen on topics concerning the Israeli economy and financial system. He has also lectured to Israeli banks and overseas financial institutions on banking and financial markets and related topics.

Landau has written numerous books, including *Opportunities in Israeli Capital Markets* (2005), *Israel till 2000: Will Immigration Drive Growth?* (1992), *Israel till 1991: Reform or Relapse* (1987) and *Israel Banking Today: Dinosaur or Phoenix?* (1988). He has also written articles that appeared in The Economist, BusinessWeek, International Herald Tribune, Wall Street Journal, Institutional Investor, Daily and Sunday London Telegraph, American Banker, among others. Landau attained a B Sc (Hons) from the London School of Economics in 1976.
